n the wake of the ongoing violence in the land we call holy, the 2024 General Assembly of the United Reformed Church has asked local congregations actively to reach out in solidarity to both Jewish and Muslim neighbours.

The International Court of
Justice has indicated that
Palestinians are plausibly at
risk of a genocide. The world
court has offered an Advisory
Opinion indicating that the Israeli
occupation of the West Bank,
East Jerusalem and Gaza is
illegal. Israeli civilian hostages
are still being held illegally by
Hamas. Our news and social

horrifying images of death and brutality in Gaza. It is tempting to despair.

Nevertheless, General Assembly has made it clear that it is wrong and dangerous to hold Jews or Muslims in the UK responsible for the violence in Israel and in the occupied territory. Rather, we must ensure that every community here is loved, respected, and protected.

Whatever your views, are you able to reach out? Write a note of support? Invite people to a meal, shared activity or upcoming event? We must consciously choose the precious path of peace rather than the snaking highway of hate.
